ACTION CENTER OVERVIEW

The Action Center has been helping the neediest in our community for over 50 years. Starting in 1968, the Action Center has helped individuals facing hunger, homelessness and financial instability. The Jefferson County Human Relations Council and Church Women United worked together the first few years creating programs from transportation pools, to food, clothing and furniture banks to handyman services and meal deliveries to fit the needs of a growing suburban county.

After working out of churches and temporary buildings for many years, the Action Center recognized the need to consolidate services into a central location and has remained on 14th Avenue, purchasing the old Lakewood post office and in 2015 expanding into an office building next door. Many core programs and activities continue to this day. The Holiday Shop was started in 1972, the first Thanksgiving food distribution began in 1998 and the school supply distribution in 1999. The Beautiful Junk sale has been a major fund raiser since 1977. In 1997, the Action Center opened the first general use homeless shelter in the county providing housing and solid programming to families, couples and individuals. In 2019, the shelter transitioned to a program for students from Red Rocks Community College.

The Action Center has grown into a respected and much loved community organization that helps individuals and families who are experiencing hardship by offering resources and services to stabilize their lives and achieve lasting change. A dedicated staff, a core of over four thousand passionate volunteers and on-site community partners put our mission to work every day through the self-service grocery, the clothing, household and personal care programs, assistance with financial needs such as rent and utility assistance, obtaining IDs and birth certificates and coaching designed to help with goal setting, accountability and resources to stabilize lives and promote pathways to self-sufficiency.

WHAT:

The Action Center and *Breaking History* TM with Ryan Avery are attempting a world record and are asking the public to please "Bring a Pair of Socks, Bring a Buck" and help them collect 10,587 pairs of NEW socks as well as \$10,587 to raise awareness of homelessness issues in Colorado. If successful in their attempt, they will break the world record for "World's Longest Sock Drive."

WHY:

On Wednesday, December 4, the Action Center in partnership with *Breaking History* [™] with Ryan Avery will attempt to break the world record of *Largest Sock Drive*. The current record is held by Temple University's Campus Program Board and was achieved in October 2017. The organization collected 2,798 socks over the course of 8 hours. All of the socks were new and donated to a local Philadelphia charity.

The Action Center, together with *Breaking History* is attempting to collect 10,587 new socks and \$10,587 from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m. on December 4. The Action Center has set this goal to highlight and bring awareness to those experiencing homelessness in Colorado. According to the U.S. Interagency Council on Homelessness, in 2018 there were 10,587 Colorado residents experiencing homelessness. As the homelessness epidemic continues to grow in Colorado, the Action Center serves those currently experiencing homelessness. The Action Center also seeks to prevent homelessness by providing food, clothing, and connecting participants with additional resources such as utility and rent assistance to Jefferson County residents or those experiencing homelessness.

In addition to collecting 10,587 pairs of new socks, the Action Center hopes that the community will "Bring a Pair of Socks, Bring a Buck" to help the organization combat homelessness. The socks will distributed to Action Center participants, the funds raised will benefit The Action Center's soon-to-re-open shelter. The shelter will be re-open as a longer-term program in partnership with Red Rocks Community College benefitting at-risk college students. The wrap around program will support students and ensure they can complete their education as well as develop a skill set that helps them prepare themselves for their lives outside of the shelter.


